Footnotes

HAMMER THE BAY set a well handled pace from the start, drew off in upper stretch and was much the best in the end. BANDINI'S DREAM chased the early pace while two wide, made a bid on the far turn but was no match in late stretch and held the place safe in the end. LIMESHARE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, was two wide in the stretch and was gaining ground to finished well but was no menace. CROW BRIDGE was unhurried early then rallied five wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain. GONE FOR HOME stalked the early pace while inside, made a bid on the far turn then came up empty in late stretch. SINNERS ANGEL was settled in the early going, rallied four wide on the far turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch drive. MOUNT ISTAN stalked the early pace while three wide, rallied on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. B G WANT ME BACK was inside and unhurried early, swung out to be five wide in mid stretch but was no menace. DEPUTY WHY was unhurried early and failed to menace. THE RIGHT MOVES was allowed to settled then raced on the inside on the far turn but faltered. HAVE A GOOD DAY was unhurried early and was no threat.
