HEY EILEEN trailed, circled the field six wide in the turn, with a late rally was up in final strides, ridden out. BELLE OF THE BAND was well placed, gained command in upper stretch, flattened out. POLISH PROVERB was well placed, dropped back, moved up to stalk the pace in upper stretch and gave way. CYNTRY made a steady advance, raced four wide in the turn and made a mild rally. MERCEDITAS with a steady advance, raced five wide in the turn and made a mild rally. PACE dropped back, was four wide in the turn, passed tiring rivals. LOEBAU STORE made a middle move, tired. BA BA BAAD set the pace and was through after a half. HOLLY SUE raced in the middle of the pack, tired. AMALERT was well placed, raced four wide in the turn, tired. SHANNONS INFERNO stalked the pace, stopped.
