DIXIE'S ACE dueled for the lead while inside, drew clear in mid stretch and was kept to task in late stretch. CONDESA EL PRADO was saving ground on the turn then rallied along the inside in the stretch, was gaining ground to finished well. PLAYIN WILD dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used then weakened in late stretch. FOXY KITTEN was inside early on then angled to the outside to be three wide heading into the turn, made a bid to late stretch but came up empty in the end. SNOW TRIP broke slowly then lugged in at the start, was settled then dropped back before the turn, started a run on the turn then moved out to be five wide and closed ground willingly in late stretch. FATE'S TREASURE saved ground on the turn then lacked a rally in the stretch drive. MINER'S TOMB raced four wide on the turn then faltered in the stretch. B G GOLDEN TIME raced five wide on the turn, was used up then stopped. MARYSLEW broke in the air and caused the rider to lost both irons then raced far back throughout.
