Footnotes

STORM TEASER broke outward and bumped hard with J LO'S HALO, settled outside of MAL'S MAGIC, raced off the rail on the turn, was blocked at the top of the stretch, made a bid between rivals passing the furlong marker and edged clear under strong handling. MAL'S MAGIC settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns, made a bid along the rail entering the final furlong but was outfinished while able to secure the place. HADAHARP was bumped just after the start, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and weakened. VALOR STORM raced four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn and came up empty. J LO'S HALO was bumped hard at the start then hustled to the lead, set the pace while off the rail, lost the lead near the furlong marker and faded. SPANISH SONG bumped with NIGHT SAILS at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled near the back of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. NIGHT SAILS bumped with a rival at the start, was caught four wide on the first turn, settled at the rear of the field, raced four wide early on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and was no factor.
