WASKO was hustled from the outside post, quickly crossed to the rail, was well rated while setting the pace, drew off near the quarter-pole and proved much the best under a strong hand ride. FIEND A BIT was rated just off the pace, chased the winner on the far turn and secured the place. TOTAL POWER settled off the pace, moved up while urged along on the backstretch, was hard ridden while saving ground on the far turn and came up empty while best of the rest. QUEENS LIGHTING was off slow, raced three wide on the first turn and failed to threaten. REAGAN JAMES raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, came up empty while three wide on the far turn and faded. TECHNICAL BARGAIN was in tight leaving the first turn, raced off the pace, went four wide early on the far turn, moved in near the five-sixteenths pole and faltered then pulled up in distress after the race and was vanned off.
