FULL STORM followed the leader from second, chased that rival on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. SERVE IT COLD settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and secured the place while no match for the winner. WHY MIKE set the clear pace, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened. ASTRANTIA lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. KALISKA was washy in the warm-up, settled off the pace and failed to respond. LILY'S PRAYER settled towards the rear of the field, moved to three wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. TRU IRON lugged out a bit while three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace and also failed to respond.
