Footnotes

CHROMEDOLL raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace while in hand, took the lead on the far turn and drew away under steady urging. FLYING PRESS settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and got up for the place. GATHERING SKY was allowed to settle into stride, held a good striking position on the far turn, raced three wide into the stretch and came up empty. SHEZA HOT TREASURE dropped to the rail leaving the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came under a ride on the far turn, moved off the rail near the quarter-pole and also came up empty. JODY'S GIRL was very rank early and taken back to last, lingered well back in the field and failed to threaten. PRESLEY was carried nine wide early on the first turn then dropped to four wide, lagged well back in the field and never reached contention. PROSPECT'S GIRL set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead on the far turn and faded. RUSHAWAY SIOUX bore out badly on the first turn, raced fourteen wide onto the backstretch and trailed. (Rail at 18 Feet)
