BLUE CREEKER was unhurried early then started a rally on the far turn while sweeping outside and came six wide in the stretch to be along in time. JOSEY HILL was saving ground throughout then rallied while two wide in the stretch, was gaining ground and finished strong but was not good enough. VICTORY WOMAN was stalking the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn and was gaining ground to finish well in late stretch. DOC'S BELLE set the early pace while being pressured, was in a long drive from the far turn to mid stretch then weakened in late stretch. WAHTOWAH BABY was on the inside and saving ground on both turns then was gaining ground in late stretch while racing along the rail. BANKRUPE was unhurried early then made a mild rally while inside in the stretch but was no threat late. SOFT N' LOUD was unhurried early then made a mild rally while four wide on the far turn, fanned out seven wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in late stretch. MISS JAZZY made a strong four wide middle move going into the far turn then flattened out in the stretch drive. BOOT SCOOTER stalked the pace while racing three wide, made a strong bid going into the far turn to range up to contention then stopped in the stretch drive. SPINNING TIME was well placed while racing two wide down the backstretch, made a strong bid going into the far turn then stopped in the stretch.
