Footnotes

STATICE was unhurried early while racing on the inside, started a run on the far turn then swung out to be three wide for the stretch drive, closed fast on the outside and powered to the front then was kept to task in late stretch to hold sway. RARE THUNDER was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be four wide for the stretch, closed fast on the outside but was too late. RARE FLYER pressed the early pace while racing two wide, rallied on the far turn to gain command in upper stretch then could not last in deep stretch. BURBON ROAD was unhurried early then was four wide on the far turn making a bid but failed to menace in the stretch. HERE COMES BADNESS chased the early pace while inside, was used up and gave way on the far turn. HEDGEFUND INVESTOR set a pressured pace while inside, was used up and stopped in the stretch. LARRY'S BLUESECRET was through after a half and stopped.
