TWO JAYS SECRET was well rated while setting the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch and proved best under steady urging. GENERAL NAEVUS raced just off the pace, moved up near the half-mile pole, steadied near the three-eighths pole, chased the leader into the stretch and secured the place while unable to threaten the winner. HOLLYE LYNNE dropped to the rear of the field then shifted in, moved up on the inside, was in tight leaving the backstretch, chased inside on the turn and weakened while able to get the show. GLORIOUS GROOM settled near the back of the field, raced near the rail on the turn and failed to rally. CEE'S THE POINT settled off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the turn and failed to respond. MEXICAN JAZZ chased the pace on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and faded.
