Footnotes

MR. SHOCK AND AWE was settled in the early going then started a rally on the far turn while three wide then swung out four wide in upper stretch and closed fast on the outside and was along in time to prove best. TAKSENT stalked the pace while racing three wide then rallied strongly on the outside and was in a strong drive to gain a narrow lead in mid stretch but hung in the end. GLENLEARY was settled in the early going then rallied three wide on the far turn and was gaining ground in deep stretch but hung in the end. FLAMEFINDER stalked the pace while racing two wide then rallied on the far turn between rivals, was in a long drive along the inside in the stretch and gamely dug in but tired in deep stretch. FAMILY LOCKET stalked the pace while inside and settled then moved up to striking position going into the far turn then faltered in the stretch. TORATORA set the early pace while being well handled, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch drive.
