HONOR AMERICA was settled in the early going then rallied six wide on the turn, was in a full flight and closed with a flourish on the outside and proved best in the end. EAGLE TWO HUNDRED dueled for the early lead while two wide, drew off in upper stretch and opened a clear lead in mid stretch but could not last in late stretch. SPEED TUNNEL chased the early pace while two wide, rallied on the turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch. TWO JAYS SECRET was on the two wide on the turn then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in late stretch. DREAM AMERICA was bumped at the start then started a run going into the turn, was bumped hard then was five wide on the turn but raced evenly in the stretch drive. MARGIN OF TRUTH on the inside on the turn and saved ground then was no threat in the stretch. GRAND PICTURE was bumped at the start then was unhurried early and was no factor. COUNTER CLAIM lugged in badly at the start and caused crowding then showed good speed while inside and dueling for the lead and stopped in the stretch. C. ME LEAVIN was bumped at the start then was hustled along, was bumped hard entering the turn and was four wide on the turn then stopped in the stretch.
