Footnotes

BARBETTE was well placed on the inside, steadied entering the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and closed strongly to get up late. PLEASANTLY BLESSED contested the pace on the inside, battled gamely in the stretch and was denied. NEW EDITION raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, vied between rivals on the far turn, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened while able to hold the show. BLOCK broke outward and bumped with a rival, lingered well back in the field, waited behind horses while three wide on the far turn, came between rivals inside the furlong marker and finished well. JENZ BENZ bumped with a rival at the start, lagged at the rear of the field, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and reached her best stride too late. FESTIVE RAIN settled while off the rail, moved out near the furlong marker and failed to rally. QUEEN LA BELLA settled off the pace, clipped heels leaving the backstretch and failed to threaten. FAIRWELL MADRID bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn and lacked the needed response. RICE 'N SPICE raced four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, moved up

near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied three wide on the far turn and tired. MYSTIC SOUL was a bit rank early, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. LEMONY CRICKET raced three to four wide on the first turn, lingered towards the rear of the field, went four to five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. EXTRA BASES contested the pace between rivals, came up empty on the far turn and stopped. (Rail at 0 Feet)
