Footnotes

CAT FACTOR bumped with a rival after the start, dueled on the outside, edged clear outside the furlong marker and proved much the best under vigorous urging. TANZALASKA dueled on the inside of CAT FACTOR, shifted outside of that rival near the three-furlong marker, vied into upper stretch and proved no match for the winner while clear for second. ROSES BULL chased the pace on the inside, moved off the rail on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while able to secure the show. EAST TEX came in after the start, was void of speed, saved ground on the turn, was bumped passing the furlong marker and improved position. POLLOCK'S PRAISE bumped with a rival after the start, was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. PROGRAMMED TO STAR chased the pace on the outside, vied four wide on the turn and tired. CRAFTY SAN PEPPY broke a bit awkwardly, settled towards the rear of the field, raced four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. BANJO MOUNTAIN bumped repeatedly with KRIS KAHLA early, was ridden along between rivals, came up empty on the turn and retreated. MFAZI raced near the middle of the field, went three to four wide on the turn, drifted in near the furlong marker and bumped EAST TEX then failed to menace. REALLY TRUCKIN was void of speed, raced off the rail on the turn and showed little. KRIS KAHLA bumped repeatedly with BANJO MOUNTAIN early, raced five wide into the turn, dropped to three wide near the five-sixteenths marker and also showed little. BAY SQUALL pressed the pace while three wide, came up empty leaving the turn and stopped.
