ANGELIC JEWEL dueled for the lead from the outside, was in a long hard drive in the stretch and held sway in the end. ZIGNOR raced five wide on the turn then rallied and was gaining ground in the stretch to finish strong but was not enough. CASTELLI'S GYPSY saved ground going into the turn then rallied three wide, made a bid to mid stretch then failed to sustained that bid in the end. GRINGA HUG raced four wide on the turn then failed to menace when asked for a late surge. RUHLETTA dueled for the lead from the inside, was hard used then gave way in the stretch. DIRTY SECRET pressed the early pace, was used up and stopped. TICKIN broke in the air and trailed throughout.
