SHE'S NO BO on the inside and assumed command just after the half, drew clear on the turn then lugged in slightly in upper stretch under right handed urging then held IGLO ALPIR safe in deep stretch. IGLO ALPIR was unhurried early then rallied five wide on the far turn, was gaining ground in the stretch and just missed at the wire. WORLD OF GOLD was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, ranged up to mid stretch then hung in the final seventy yards. UNRAVEL was unruly in the post parade then raced on the inside saving ground, was making a bid on the far turn then was blocked in upper stretch and lacked a late bid. SHE'S THE FUTURE stalked the pace while three wide, made a bid on the turn then gave way in the stretch. CRESTING TIDE was no threat. BUSTIC set the early pace and drew off on the first turn, was used up and gave way. ABOUT LOVE was fractious in the paddock being saddled then unruly in the post parade, showed brief speed and stopped after a half.
