GOOSEY MOOSE was well place while three wide then rallied on the far turn to be in strong drive with CATALISSA then put that rival away in late stretch and proved best. CATALISSA rallied four wide on the far turn then made a strong bid to gain a narrow lead in mid stretch then failed to sustain that bid in the end. LIGHTS ON BROADWAY was on the inside on the backstretch then rallied on the far turn, swung out three wide in upper stretch and finished well late. R B J'S BLAZE was settled then rallied on the turn, swung out five wide in upper stretch then came up empty in the drive. DESERT DARBY was unhurried early then made a mild rally three wide on the 2nd turn but was no threat in the stretch. RARE CURE dueled for the lead from the inside, was hard used then gave way in the stretch drive. ONCEAROUNDTWICE raced between horses on the backstretch then stopped in the stretch. RECORD ASSEMBLY dueled for the lead from the outside, was used up and stopped in upper stretch. THERE GOES ROCKET raced three wide on the backstretch then stopped in upper stretch.
