Footnotes

CAPTAIN COUNTDOWN reserved early along inside, moved to the lead between horses entering final turn, drew clear and increased advantage in the stretch. IMABLUESFAN unhurried early, became a factor along inside approaching final turn, eased out for the drive, pulled away from the others while no threat to the winner. DELAWARE LINE forwardly placed outside, weakened in the drive, but was able to safely hold the show. HOLLYWOOD PLUMBER well back early, began picking up rivals while racing outside final turn, lugged in briefly near the eighth pole and continued to improve position. SOVEREIGN RIP TORN outrun early while saving ground, eased out from rail final turn and passed tired rivals. COZ Z NELSON wide in the stretch, was never prominent. DEER DIARY veered out at the start, settled outside the early leaders, tired straightening for home. HESA CADILLAC trailed early and was always outrun along inside. P'VILLE'S PRIDE showed early foot between horses, faltered final turn, bore out straightening for home and lugged in near the eighth pole. PINE SILK was through early. MARCUS L seized the early lead, eased in once clear, was displaced near the three eighths pole and gave way badly.
