Footnotes

HEZA FAST TAB void of early speed, moved with a rush five deep late on the turn, gained the advantage entering the stretch, eased inside and drew clear. STOWE CREEK well back early, started picking up rivals on the turn, rallied while five wide in the drive. CHIEF THREE SOX trailed early, swung seven wide into the stretch and finished with a rush. T.L. TIME reserved early, drove into contention between horses near quarter pole, went evenly in the drive. RHONESQUARTERSWISH outrun early, improved position while six wide in the stretch. COUNTRY CRUISE forwardly placed early, raced four wide on the turn, remained a factor to the final stages and weakened. IDAHADER gained the early lead while racing outside, was headed late backstretch, raced forwardly to near the sixteenth pole and faded. ACKADACKADOO took the lead along inside just before going three furlongs, was displaced nearing the three sixteenths pole and tired. LOCKWOOD prominently positioned between horses, steadied near the quarter pole and faltered. MORALESA was through along inside entering the turn.
