Footnotes

ONLY MAN IN TOWN was settled on the inside and saving ground on the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the far turn then was in a strong drive to take command in mid stretch then drew clear in late stretch. WACO ZONE dueled for the lead from inside on the backstretch, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch but held the place safe in the end. BEAN was unhurried early and kept to the inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn then rallied and angled out to be four wide in mid stretch, was gaining ground in late stretch but was no menace in the end. DE ICE CAT was allowed to settled on the run down the backstretch while racing three wide, made a bid on the far turn but flattened out in late stretch. HEZA TWELTH MAN was settled while racing inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn then failed to respond when asked in upper stretch. MARGIN OF TRUTH was unhurried early and raced five wide on the first turn, was five wide on the far turn and made a mild gain but was no threat. FIRST TO HUNT was allowed to settled while racing two wide on the backstretch then failed to menace in the stretch. GOING SOUTH dueled for the lead while two wide, was

used up and gave way in the stretch. MY FRIEND JIM was inside on the backstretch saving ground throughout then faltered on the far turn. UNFORSEEN TERMS raced four wide on the backstretch and was no threat. EXPECT NO EQUAL was bumped at the start then unhurried early and was no factor. COLD DAWN was allowed to settled then stopped.
