HOLLYE LYNNE was settled in the early going then rallied three wide on the far turn, gained command in upper stretch and drew clear and was much the best. SWEET IDEA was inside and stalking the early pace then was shuffled back going into the far turn and steadied when PARTY OF ONE fell at the quarter pole then came out to be four wide and was no match for the winner. MAGIC MONEY MEG was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn, made a mild gain in the stretch and was no menace late. DANCING DUDETE was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, made a mild gain in the stretch and was no menace. SWEET APPEAL set the early pace while being pressured, was hard used then weakened on the far turn. NURSE DYNA stalked the pace while two wide, made a bid on the far turn while two wide then had her heels clipped at the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch drive. PARTY OF ONE stalked the early pace while racing two wide then was between rivals on the far turn and behind the leaders, clipped heels with NURSE DYNA and fell heavily just past the quarter pole then was walked off. A steward's inquiry was held concerning the incident on the far turn. After reviewing the film's, no action was taken.
