LOUETTA was well placed then made a four wide bid on the turn while in hand to draw clear then held off the late challenge of TRIPLE SPIN while being kept to pressure to the wire. TRIPLE SPIN was allowed to settle while saving ground then was five wide at the top of the stretch and closed well late and was gaining on the winner to the wire. DANDY DULCE was allowed to settle then was four wide at the top of the stretch while making a bid but flattened out late. LADIF was void of early speed then was fanned nine wide at the top of the stretch and passed then tiring rivals. SISTER'S SHAMROCK was allowed to settle then improved her position late. GUADALUPE was settled back early then lacked a rally. ENERGYWITHATTITUDE stumbled at the start and vied for the lead in between rivals then weakened. JEWELS N JADE was outrun early then was no factor. JUST A BARONESS vied for the lead three wide and gave way in the stretch. KATO'S WORLD vied for the lead on the inside then tired. TEXAS PEGASUS was in mid pack then dropped back.
