Footnotes

LITTLE BRICK LANE tracked the pace on the inside, took the lead near the three-eighths pole, drew clear in upper stretch and held well under right hand urging. SPECIAL AGENT JOE went three to four wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, raced four wide on the far turn and secured the place while no threat to the winner. INTI RAYMI set the pace while off the rail, lost the lead near the three-eighths pole, vied into the stretch and tired while able to hold the show. TUNNEL MAN raced three then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. AJFIREBALL was allowed to settle into stride, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. SQUEAKY WIND raced off the rail on both turns and was outrun. MF AZI raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came up empty near the quarter-pole and faded.
