SHANNONS VALENTINE vied for the early lead in between horses, then fought on gamely to the finish while being outfinished by the winner. VALID DESIRE vied for the early lead three wide but needed more late. DOUBLETROUBLE BEAR chased the early pace but had no rally. WISHING TO WIN lacked a rally. SOUTHERNSTURN passed the tiring rivals. GRACEFUL CADY vied for the early lead four wide and weakened. EXPECTING SUGAR raced wide and weakened. CRYSTAL K. K. was not a factor. MISS CRIMSON PINE showed little.
