TIN TOP CAT moved up to race just off the pace, chased three wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, inched clear inside the furlong marker and held under strong urging. RUBY'S BIG BAND settled off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and finished willingly but missed. DIXIELAND BABY raced towards the rear of the field and finished willingly but missed the place. PROUD PLAYER contested the pace, vied into the final furlong and weakened. CUVANDO was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. SWEETSWEETRAMONA raced well back in the field, went three wide on the turn and improved position. LEGENDARY DAY was hard ridden while off the pace, raced five wide on the turn and failed to respond. CAT BELLS bumped with a rival at the start, raced towards the rear of the field, went four wide on the turn, moved to six wide near the quarter-pole and came up empty. BUD'S LITTLE EDGE was reserved off the pace, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and had nothing left. FAVORITE DANCER chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn and faded. MESCALERESS was fractious in the gate, bumped with a rival at the start, dropped to the rear of the field and was no factor. SOMETHING LOVELY was urged along while off the pace, raced four to five wide on the turn and faltered. SARA'S WILD contested the pace, vied into the stretch and stopped.
