VALID HEART was settled in the early going and saving ground, rallied coming out of the turn then split rivals in mid stretch, moved outside of RANGE WAR and wore that rival down in the final strides. RANGE WAR set a pressured pace from the inside, drew off in mid stretch while in a strong drive but could not last in the final seventy yards. BG SILVER SNOW rallied on the turn while three wide, made a strong bid nearing the quarter pole but flattened out in the stretch drive. SALT LICK was void of early speed and settled, rallied coming out of the turn and swung out to be four wide for the stretch drive, closed ground willingly in late stretch but was no menace in the end. SILENT BOOM chased the early pace while inside, made a bid on the turn to upper stretch but faltered in the drive. DANCE ALL THE WAY was unhurried early then made a mild gain while inside in the stretch but was no threat. KRISTYS EXPLOSION chased the early pace while racing two wide, bore out at the top of the stretch and gave way. WABASH pressed the early pace while two wide, was used up and stopped.
