Footnotes

LUCKY TUNNEL was well placed behind the leaders, made a three wide bid passing the quarter pole, took over at the top of the stretch, and drew clear under steady right hand urging. SHE'S A DEPUTY TOO stalked the pace under a tight hold, drew even entering the final turn, led briefly inside the quarter pole, but was headed by LUCKY TUNNEL at the top of the stretch, and proved no match while clearly second best. LACE CASTELLI hopped slightly at the start, settled well back in the field, advanced along the rail on the final turn, split foes passing the quarter pole, and was best of the rest. MARXIE raced four wide on the first turn, went four or five wide on the second turn, and improved position without threatening. CINEMAGIC raced four wide on both turns, and failed to rally. FRISK FOR JADE angled over to save ground after the start, raced unhurried near the back of the field, and never reached contention. TRUTH BY RUTH raced five wide on the first turn, surged to the lead early on the backstretch, vied through the far turn, and faded. TIGER HUNTER was always outrun. BIGTIMEAFFAIR was forwardly placed from the start, was in good striking range passing the quarter pole, but came up empty. GOLD FOLLEY was caught six wide on the first turn, raced up close to the pace, and was through after five furlongs.
