Footnotes

HELLO FROM HEAVEN was reserved on the inside, waited while blocked passing the quarter-pole, swung out entering the stretch, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker then edged clear under strong urging. LONE STAR BREW was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the inside of IMA FIVE STAR, inched clear entering the final furlong but was overtaken while clear for the place. AKA LILY'S LAD raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased four then three wide on the far turn and weakened. IMA FIVE STAR was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the outside, vied into the stretch and gave way. CATAPULT SHOT lagged at the back of the field, remained well back into the stretch and failed to threaten. WHIZVILLE tracked the leaders from third, chased three wide on the far turn and faded. RARE CHANCE shifted four wide late on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, raced four wide on the far turn and faltered.
