DUSTY TUNNEL was between rivals on the backstretch then rallied three wide going into the far turn, was put into a long drive to be best. VAL'S APPROVAL raced two wide early on then rallied three wide on the far turn, made a strong bid to mid stretch then hung in the final stages. POWERSHOT on the inside going into the far turn, was gaining ground in the stretch to finish well. BERT'S GHOST chased the pace while inside, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. KOUNTRY GRAMMER set the early pace and opened a clear lead, was used up and tired in the stretch. MICK AND BUBBA was unhurried early then passed tiring in the stretch. PAPEETE failed to menace. UNIQUE RONIQUÉ made a three wide middle move on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch. RIVER SMILE raced three wide on the backstretch and gave way. HIGH DANGIG was void of early speed and showed little.
