REGAL ENTRY chased the pace, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, battled gamely with LOST TEMPERANCE in the stretch and proved best under strong urging. LORD TEMPERANCE dueled on the inside, battled gamely in the stretch but was outfinished while well clear for the place. MEAN N BRITE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to rally while best of the rest. SIR NINER was hard ridden on the outside, raced five then four wide on the turn and came up empty. DEVINELY UNIQUE was reluctant to load then broke a bit slow, raced at the rear of the field and improved position without threatening. BULLITTCANRUN was urged along while off the pace, steadied off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole and came up empty. ROCKY'S HALF raced off the pace while ridden along, was taken up a bit near the three-eighths pole, went four wide early on the turn then dropped in and had nothing left. KATARRA was returned to the paddock for a new rider, broke a bit awkwardly, raced five wide on the turn and was no factor. ADMIRAL APPLE JACK chased the pace, dropped in on the turn and faded. ROAD MONEY broke a bit slow, was ridden along while off the pace and failed to respond. HALO'S WILDFIRE dueled on the outside, vied into the stretch and stopped.
