Footnotes

SABINCIELO settled inside on the first turn, moved out on the backstretch, shifted five wide nearing the quarter-pole, rallied into the stretch, closed well to make a bid near the furlong marker, battled with WACO HUG late and prevailed under urging. WACO HUG raced four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, rallied between rivals in upper stretch, split foes to make a bid entering the final furlong, battled with SABINCIELO late and missed. AUDREY'S LAD lagged well back in the field, raced four to five wide on the far turn, closed well to make a bid nearing the furlong marker but proved no match for the top two while clear for the show. ATREVIDO BANDITO was in tight on the first turn and bumped with a rival, raced just behind the leader near the inside, shifted three wide to make a bid on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. EIGHTPOINTTWO was well rated while setting the pace, vied inside on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way. SKU settled in the middle of the field, raced off the rail on the turns and failed to rally. KEYSTONE CAT raced well back in the field, went four to five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. BARCLAY DRIVE raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. LEEWAY bumped with a rival on the first turn,

tracked the pace, vied between rivals on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and also came up empty. DOUBLE INTRIGUE raced in the middle of the field early, went three to four wide on the far turn and faltered. WESTERN RUNAWAY raced well back in the field and showed little. DEPUTY TICE raced three wide on the first turn, retreated after a half-mile and was pulled up in the stretch but walked off.
