Footnotes

HIGH CASCADE was well placed behind the leaders, waited patiently while saving ground on the turn, slipped through along the rail at the top of the stretch, kicked clear outside the furlong marker, and proved best under strong hand urging. CAVEATS PROSPECT lacked early speed, angled out at the top of the stretch, and finished willingly to get the place. ROYAL MAMBO settled at the back of the field, saved ground into the stretch, and also finished willingly. SCREEN PASS raced off the early leaders, vied between foes in upper stretch, but lacked the needed response. EXCESSIVE BEHAVIOR was never far back, dueled between horses on the turn, and weakened in the stretch drive. COWBOY TOUGH dueled between rivals on the turn, dropped out near the furlong marker, and tired. FLY SLAMA JAMA moved up leaving the backstretch, dueled four wide on the turn, came five wide into the lane, and faded. KOOL KOOL was away alertly from the outside post, sped clear then crossed to the rail, dueled on the inside of three rivals on the turn, dropped out in upper stretch, and gave way.
