**Footnotes**

THUNDERPANTS raced on the inside then was shuffled back heading into the turn, saved ground on the turn and rallied in upper stretch along the inside, slipped through the inside to be in a strong drive and proved best in the final strides. GOING SOUTH vied for the lead from the inside, was in a long sustained drive throughout the stretch, gamely dug in then was outfinished in late stretch while finishing on even terms with GLASS MACHINE for the place. GLASS MACHINE vied for the lead while racing three wide, was in a long drive on the outside and gamely dug in throughout the stretch but was outfinished in late stretch to finish on even terms for the place. WILD WEST WIND was settled then bore out heading into the turn, was angled inside in upper stretch and made a mild rally in late stretch but was no menace in the end. COOK'S NOOK vied for the lead while four wide, was hard used on the turn then weakened in the stretch. BOOM BOOM BUBBA was bumped when heading into the turn and forced out then raced four wide in upper stretch but was no menace. LIL JET SETTER vied for the lead while racing five wide, was used up on the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. HE'S BOY WONDER was

carried out on the turn to be five wide and failed to menace. ROUGH EDGE raced five wide on the turn and was outrun. JOE MOVE vied for the early lead while two wide, was used up and stopped on the turn.
