SECRET SIP prompted the pace and made a bid to draw clear then held on late while being kept to pressure. MELO NOTE was allowed to settle then was six wide on the turn and closed. WESTERN BOWL was well placed and slipped through on the rail but needed more. SHEER SABLE was allowed to settle and had a belated rally. TRICKLE DOWN was settled back early then was going well late. RAINMOM was void of early speed then angled out nine wide in the stretch and found best stride late. ONE TO FIVE set the pace three wide and gave way. UNIQUE CREEK failed to menace. FIRST FINAL chased the pace and weakened. LADY LIVERMORE had a four wide trip and had no response. SIZZLIN SOUTH pressed the pace four wide and weakened. MISS T J was allowed to settle and dropped back.
