DESERT AIR showed early outside speed, took the lead just before going three furlongs, drew clear and eased inside, pulled away final furlong. PUTINAGOODWORD was not asked for early speed while saving ground, eased out on the backstretch, moved strongly four deep final turn, reached striking position after six furlongs, was no match for the winner late, but was able to save the place. HEZA FAST TAB trailed early, began picking up rivals along inside final turn, eased between horses for the drive and was going well late. WIND RIDGE outrun early, started advancing outside final turn, entered the stretch four deep and finished evenly. CHIEF THREE SOX well back early, swung five wide for the drive and improved position without threatening. TEXAS SHUTTLE outrun early, passed beaten rivals while six wide in the stretch. CAR SALESMAN forced the early pace along inside, tired late final turn. SHAMAN CHOCOLATE settled off the early leaders, was finished between horses entering stretch. DOCTOR S gained the early lead between horses, was headed soon after entering backstretch, faltered in the drive. MR. RICH up close early, was through before going three-quarters.
