LEEWAY settled in third, ranged up on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled gamely with T. D. JAGUAR JONES in the final furlong and prevailed under strong urging. T. D. JAGUAR JONES quickly sprinted clear, set the pace, was challenged at the top of the stretch, battled with LEEWAY in the final furlong and was denied. WW CONQUISTADOR settled near the back of the field, lacked room while three wide on the turn, rallied entering the final furlong and closed well but was too late. GUACAMOLE brushed with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and finished willingly. DUSTY TUNNEL was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but flattened out. MR. SMEE brushed with a rival at the start, raced towards the rear of the field, was blocked from the five-sixteenths pole into upper stretch and failed to threaten when clear. RIZZI MONEY lacked early speed, raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. GOLD ROLICK chased the pace into the turn and retreated. TORATORA was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and faltered.
