ADDIN UP contested the pace on the inside, edged clear in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. OCEAN INDY raced four then three wide on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, improved position while three wide on the far turn, shifted in leaving that turn and earned the place while no match for the winner. WACO LYPHARD contested the pace on the outside, vied into the stretch and tired while clear for the show. LAST CONQUISTADOR raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, dropped back while ridden along on the far turn and tired. C. M. WIN was well placed on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. PROSPECTING AGENDA was caught five wide on the first turn, raced well back in the field, went four wide on the far turn and was no factor. LONE STRIKER settled well off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. MARKED MONEY shifted five wide late on the first turn and was always outrun. SADIE'S MEMOIRS came out at the start, was caught six wide into the first turn, dropped to four wide midway through that turn, was hard ridden on the backstretch, raced three wide on the far turn and faltered.
