AIRIZON brushed with a rival at the start, set the pace under pressure, drew clear in upper stretch and proved much the best under steady urging. CAPE SUNSET was last away, settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn, slipped through inside rivals in upper stretch and proved no match while up for the place. SHARON RAE pressed the pace near the inside, chased the winner on the turn and tired. FRESA MARGARITA dropped back at the start, settled on the outside, was ridden along while four wide on the turn and failed to rally. MISS KNOW IT ALL chased the pace through the turn and faded. SILK MARKET brushed with a rival at the start, raced just off the pace, held a good striking position into the stretch but came up empty. CORPORATE'S MARKET lacked speed while ridden along, raced four then three wide on the turn and was outrun.
