Weights Friday, July 4, 2003. (High weights preferred). Starters to be named through the entry box on Thursday, July 10 by the usual time of closing. Closed Sunday, June 29 with fifty-four (54) nominations.

Footnotes

DUSTY SPIKE settled outside while unhurried in the early going, moved up five wide going to the far turn, made a quick bid to contention while remaining wide approaching the stretch, reached the leaders in upper stretch and edged clear late. TONIGHT RAINBOW was on the pace inside ROCKING TRICK to edge clear on the second turn, dug in gamely as that one came again going to the far turn and refused to yield until deep stretch while just saving the place. STORMY IMPACT tucked in behind the early pace going to the first turn, saved ground throughout and rallied willingly up the rail through the lane to just fall short of the place. VITO CORLEONE stalked the pace racing three wide while never far back, swung out after turning for home to move outside the winner in the stretch and was outfinished late. ROCKING TRICK (ARG) forced the pace outside TONIGHT RAINBOW to lose some ground and settled back through the second turn, rallied back to reach that rival into the far turn and show in front briefly in upper stretch then weakened only slightly late while missing in a blanket finish. WINNING CONNECTION stalked the pace racing three to four wide in reach of the pace, eased out nearing the lane then swung widest once straightened for home and could not produce the needed late effort. BAKER ROAD was three to four wide on the first turn, angled to the inside turning into the stretch for the first time, saved ground the remainder but failed to produce a bid. FLYIN BRIAN broke a step slow with his head turned when the gate opened, saved ground and failed to threaten. KANSAS PIONEER tracked the pace racing four wide for a half and tired.
