CLASSY AFFAIR forced the pace from outside PRECIOUS AFFAIR through the opening half mile while under a rating hold, was joined by BUMPER'S SHADOW in late backstretch, confidently repelled the bid of that rival into the far turn while continued from the three to four path, was roused once briskly entering the lane and drew off. BUMPER'S SHADOW stalked the pace from four wide to bid in late backstretch and get nearly even with the winner but was turned away through the far turn and could not match strides while clearly best of the others. LIL GIRL stalked the leaders racing out from the rail, weakened through the far turn but improved position. PRECIOUS AFFAIR contested the pace inside her stablemate for a half mile, continued to the final turn but shortened up nearing the lane. HEARTBREAK WARFARE was four wide through the first turn, angled in to save ground leaving that bend and tired.
