**Footnotes**

AMARGOSA broke inward to bump with COUNTING WEST, contested the early lead outside that one to edge clear late in the first turn, continued from three to four path the remainder, dug in as LORNA'S TAPIT challenged into the far turn and continued well to the wire to hold safe. LORNA'S TAPIT stalked the pace from four wide to bid going to the far turn, continued with the winner the remainder but could not get past. HATS N' HEELS was shuffled back at the break between rivals, saved ground just off the leaders, angled out in the far turn to come five wide into the lane and closed but could not run down the top pair. SENIORITA STARZ broke outward, saved ground to the far turn, angled out in that bend to move four wide into the lane but could not mount a closing bid. LOTTERY LASS floated six wide into the first turn, continued from four wide in the far turn and could not threaten. COUNTING WEST lunged then was bumped by the winner at the break, briefly contested the lead inside that one and tired.
