Maiden and Claiming races not considered in allowances. First Preference to horses that have raced only in Nebraska since February 12, 2009. Second Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings in 2009.

BROKEN CONNECTION settled back off the pace racing three wide, mounted his rally through the far turn then swung five wide for the drive and closed with a strong late run to prevail in the closing jump. SENOR SMILEY was carried out a bit in the first turn as a rival bore out, rallied to the leaders going to the far turn, bid four wide and moved clear turning for home then just failed to last. TIDAL STORM was back off the pace racing outside, came in on a rival in late backstretch, angled back out to move four wide into the lane and made a mild late run. WHOLELOTTA RICHTER stumbled a bit at the start but quickly recovered to contest the pace from outside KING TYMATT then weakened a bit late. MISSION ENVISIONED moved up late from the outside while not a threat. CONCLUSIVE bore out into the first turn and nearly clipped the heels of SENOR SMILEY, was taken inside then checked in late backstretch as another rival came in and lacked a further response. The rider of CONCLUSIVE lodged a claim of foul against TIDAL STORM alleging interference in late backstretch which was not allowed. KING TYMATT dueled on the pace from inside WHOLELOTTA RICHTER to late in the far turn and tired.
