BLUMIN ATTITUDE was under a tight hold and took up off the heels of HESO into the first turn to move outside that one, moved clear into the second turn, continued on a short lead the remainder and shook free through the far turn then held the margin under an energetic hand ride. SKWHIRL steadied in behind the leaders late in the first turn, remained along the inside to stalk the pace in good position, continued on willingly in the lane and moved clear for his position but could not go with the winner. BLUMIN WON stalked the pace in good position while three to four wide, moved up in the lane but could not close on the top pair. SHOW MY DANCER bumped with HESO at the start then steadied in behind the leaders while three wide in the first turn, settled in good position then made a mild bid into the far turn and weakened nearing the lane. WILL REIN saved ground and made a mild late run while not a serious threat. LARRYLARRYLARRY stalked the pace from outside and lacked a closing response. HESO bumped with SHOW MY DANCER at the start, tracked the pace from outside that one and tired.
