Footnotes

CATNIRO was on the pace while between foes through the first two turns, dug in when challenged by BAKER ROAD into the far turn to briefly kick clear in upper stretch then gamely held that rival save under a steady right-handed whip in the closing sixteenth. BAKER ROAD stalked the pace three wide to late backstretch, brushed with VITO CORLEONE as that one came off the inside approaching the far turn, lost a bit of ground into the lane but came back gamely to be slowly getting to the winner late. MINER'S PRIZE settled outside after a quarter mile, angled out four wide heading up the backstretch to mount his rally four to five wide into the stretch and closed willingly but was too late. VITO CORLEONE was a close up factor along the inside to late backstretch, came off the inside and brushed with BAKER ROAD going to the far turn while still close up but weakened through the lane. TAHKODHA HILLS angled three wide through the far turn to mount a mild bid but offered no late run. GEORGE TAYLOR failed to threaten racing three to four wide. HOUSTON SLUE trailed while saving ground and failed to mount a bid.
