Horses must be eligible at time of entry. With \$10,000 of which 60% to the Winner, 20% to 2nd, 12% to 3rd, 5% to 4th and 3% to Fifth. Additionally, all remaining finishers to receive \$300 each.

Footnotes

SWEN RAY moved to the front racing about the three path going to the first turn, remained out in the track on a short lead then widened a bit in the lane under steady handling. SAX NOTES broke inward to brush with a rival then came in on horses from four wide into the first turn to cause congestion, remained outside to bid four wide into the far turn then could not go with the winner in the lane. STORMY DATE stalked the leaders in good position along the inside but lacked a closing response. ARMY OFFICER brushed with a rival at the break then was caught in tight between rivals into the first turn, checked then clipped the heels of SAX NOTES, moved outside to rally into contention five wide on the far turn but could not threaten late. Following a claim of foul by the rider of ARMY OFFICER against SAX NOTES for interference into the first turn, SAX NOTES was disqualified and placed fourth. LOONEY LIONEL saved ground in reach of the pace, angled out through the lane but could not menace. DEFENDER'S WORD checked from tight quarters along the inside into the first turn, angled out to follow the pace from four wide and failed to rally. WHOLELOTTA RICHTER tracked the early pace from four wide and tired. RED HOT FEVER was five wide in the first turn, angled in heading up the backstretch but was outrun. DAKOTA REBEL trailed the field throughout

and was eased into the stretch but completed the course. R R GOLD was rank heading up the backstretch, bore out nearing the far turn and was pulled up then walked off under his own power.
