SOOKIE'S KOOKIES was just off the leaders while in traffic and under a snug hold, moved in hand to challenge through the far turn and draw clear then was under steady urging in the lane to draw off. SOUNDS BETTER saved ground just off the pace, rallied clear for the place in the lane but could not threaten the winner. MISS STRYKER made the pace under slow fractions while racing out from the rail, continued with the leaders to midway of the far turn and had little left. DEVILS KISS saved ground to the far turn, angled four and five wide through that bend and moved up but could not threaten. HUSKER RIDGE was with the pace racing three to four wide to the far turn and tired. MAGIC PLAYER failed to mount a rally racing four wide. BLUMIN MEMORIES ducked out sharply at the break then rushed up four wide in the first turn to vie on the lead, gave way nearing the far turn and dropped out.
