Footnotes

WAYNE A BLUE stalked the early leaders from four wide to bid into the far turn, edged clear into the lane then held safe late as PROFITABLE made his late run. PROFITABLE saved ground while unhurried early, launched his rally inside through the far turn, angled out through upper stretch and continued strongly but could not run down the winner. WOO PIG SOOIE moved to a short lead racing about the three path, continued to upper stretch and came up empty late. SOME CHARMER rushed up inside to contest the early pace, continued to prompt through the second turn then weakened and drifted out nearing the lane. ROSSINI RED saved ground and failed to mount a bid. MONARCH'S SHUFFLE failed to mount a bid racing three wide. SAUNA BOY stalked the pace from outside and tired. MINOR LEAGER checked while inside rivals and showing early speed in the first turn, angled out going to the second turn to stalk from four wide and tired.
