Nonwinners of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2007 allowed 2 lbs., Of \$15,000 at a mile or over in 2007, 4 lbs., \$15,000 in 2007, 6 lbs., \$10,000 in 2007, 8 lbs. Horses that have started for a claiming price of \$10,000 or less in 2007 to receive least preference. Total earnings in 2007 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. High Weights Preferred. Closed Sunday, July 8 with forty nine nominations.

Footnotes

TEPEXPAN showed in front at the break and moved to a short lead from inside BIG GLORI, shook free heading up the backstretch then drew off into the lane while kept under steady urging then was taken in hand through the closing yards. FIRST CLASS BRASS saved ground while allowed to settle back off the early pace, continued along the inside to the far turn then was angled out to mount his rally three wide into the lane and finished well to move well clear for the place while no match for the winner. BYE BYE BEYLEN saved ground while near the back of the pace early, moved out to rally three wide through the far turn then came out into the lane and was up for the show from widest. JOE SIX PACK stalked the pace from three wide, was fanned five wide on the second turn as the field bunched near the front, reached striking position going to the far turn then could not hold position in the lane. YOURMONEYSNOGOOD tucked inside going through the home stretch for the first time, prompted the pace in good position but weakened through the far turn. SCARAMOUCHE stalked the early pace from three wide, came out to fan rivals wide into the second turn, remained in reach of the pace to late backstretch and tired. DUSTY SPIKE failed to mount a rally while three and four wide and tired nearing the lane. NINE K ENIGMA stalked the pace as a close up factor from three wide to the far turn and tired. BIG GLORI pressed the pace from outside the winner to late backstretch, checked from heavy traffic as the leaders bunched going to the far turn and dropped out. DAUGER was fanned widest into the second turn and tired.
