Footnotes

ARMY OFFICER tracked the leaders racing three to four wide, made his run going to the far turn, edged clear into the lane then held safe late as LOONEY LIONEL made a late charge. LOONEY LIONEL was in tight quarters going to the first turn while in traffic, settled just off the winner to stalk in good position, rallied into the lane from outside that one and closed to narrowly miss. BAY TALK was five wide into the first turn while midpack, settled off the pace racing about three wide then rallied through the lane but could not reach the top pair. CONCLUSIVE bobbled away from the gate but quickly recovered to rush up inside and prompt the pace of R R GOLD, continued inside but could not go with the top ones late. WORKIN' THE CROWD broke into the side of the gate and was slow into stride, angled out in the far turn to move three wide then fanned seven wide into the lane and moved up while not a threat. R R GOLD was hustled up to the lead from outside CONCLUSIVE, continued from three wide to the far turn and weakened. FLOODGATE saved ground and was outrun. LAMBADA stalked the pace racing three to four wide and tired. RESONATE saved ground and failed to mount a bid.
