**Footnotes**

KENTUCKY MILE saved ground out from the rail while unhurried early, moved close going to the far turn, angled five and six wide approaching the lane and moved clear under steady handling. SUGARDAZZLE saved ground through the first turn, angled out leaving that bend to stalk from five wide then moved up in the lane but could not threaten the winner. COMEDY KID tracked the pace from four wide to bid and edge clear through the final turn then came up empty in the drive. FLEXTHEGOLDENPIPES moved to a clear lead racing about the three path early, continued on the pace to the far turn and had little left nearing the lane. BROKEN CONNECTION stalked the pace from five wide to bid midway up the backstretch and weakened. SEAL OF THE PEARL was not a factor racing three and four wide.
